<p>D1a. James Garrett who died. Jan 10 1879 aged 69 years also Dorcas Garrett our dear mother who entered into rest Feb 7. 1902 aged 75 years “Thy will be done” (Number D2a on 1980 survey)</p>	
<p>D2. Sacred to the memory of JAS. Garrett the beloved husband of Judith Garrett who died 3rd December 18(4)5 in the (70th) year. Judith (wife of) the above died (Mar. 21st) 1867.</p>

<p>D3. Sacred to the memory of Lucy Harling who died March 31st 1848 aged 47 years. Also of Eleanor Short sister of the above who died Feby 3rd 1829 aged 26 years.</p>	
<p>D4. Sacred to the memory of James Remmonds who departed this life 15th March 1862 aged 81 years. "The Lord hath heard my supplication, the Lord will receive my (prayer)." Ps(alms 6 v 9) (?)nley (Yarm?)outh</p>	
<p>D5. Sacred to the memory of Joseph Crane the beloved husband of Mary Crane who departed this life on the 22 (August) 1839 aged 68 years. Epitath very worn: "One (softly bad....?) And Th Dd"</p>

<p>D6. Sacred to the memory of Susan the beloved wife of John Bessey who died 15th Dec. 1842 aged 65 years. "Farewell dear friends why sigh your heart Since God ordained that we should part I would not have you grieve in vain In heaven I hope to meet again."</p>	
<p>D7. Sacred to the memory of John Bessey who departed this life 25th March 1855 in the 80th year of his age. "Dear neighbour stop and cast an eye As you are now so once was I As I am now so you must be Therefore prepare to follow me."</p>	
<p>D8. Sacred to the memory of William Bessey who departed this life on the 11th of Feb 1840 aged 68 years. "(though?) death will never be denied (...) (...) (both?) (n..) should divide Lord grant that we may meet again In heaven for ever and alway(s?)"</p>

<p>D9. (Close to) this stone lies the remains of John the husband of Mary Remmonds who died Feby. 9th 1819 aged 89 years. This stone is erected (by) (Joh)n and James their sons.</p>	
<p>D10. Shown in 1980 survey as an unreadable plaque on the church wall. No visible sign of it in 2008.</p>	<p>No sign of this plaque</p>
<p>D11. In memory of Charles the beloved husband of Elizth Bessey who died Octb. 27th 1866 aged 85 years. He was corporal in H.M. 34th Regt. And was engaged in eight battles during the Peninsular War.</p>

Also to the memory of Ann Coleby the wife of Charles Coleby who died April 11th 1850 aged 83 years and who is interred in St. George's Tomblaud Norwich Also of Agnes Rand Coleby granddaughter of the above who died March 1st 1831 aged 10 months</p>	
<p>D16. In loving memory of William Allen who died May 6th 1875 aged 50 years and Thirza his beloved wife who died Nov. 1 1888 aged 56 years. Also three of their children and six grandchildren. And of John Fulcher the beloved Husband of Hannah Fulcher and brother of the above Thirza Allen who died Dec. 17 1888 aged 52 years and is now interred in Bow Cemetery London.</p>	
<p>D17. In loving memory of Hannah widow of the late John Fulcher who died Nov. 5 1894 aged 56 years. "Her pain and grief are o'er And life's fierce storms are passed. Safe she reached the heavenly shore Where joys unfading last." Perfitt.</p>

<p>D22. In memory of James De(ek)er (Clerk) of this (pa)rish the husband of Mary Deeker who died March 9th 1813 aged 6(2) years. "Mingled with the dust I lay In hope of pardoning love Where Jesus sits enthron'd in light In that bright world above."</p>	
<p>D23. In affectionate remembrance of Robert Smith who died Jan.9th 1909 aged 85 years. "A light from our household gone A voice we loved is stilled; A place is vacant in our home Which never can be filled." Perfitt</p>

<p>D25. In loving memory of Annie the beloved daughter of William and Sarah Millett who died Jan. 2 1884 aged 13 years. “Weep not she is not dead but sleepeth.” Luke VIII 52.</p>	
<p>D26. Sacred to the memory of Emma the beloved daughter of Will m and Hannah Colls who died 11th July 1849 - - - - - ground level</p> <p>(aged 21)</p>
