




D6. Sacred to the memory of Susan the beloved wife of John Bessey who died 15th Dec. 1842 aged 65 years. "Farewell dear friends why sigh your heart Since God ordained that we should part I would not have you grieve in vain In heaven I hope to meet again."	
D7. Sacred to the memory of John Bessey who departed this life 25th March 1855 in the 80th year of his age. "Dear neighbour stop and cast an eye As you are now so once was I As I am now so you must be Therefore prepare to follow me."	
D8. Sacred to the memory of William Bessey who departed this life on the 11th of Feb 1840 aged 68 years. "(though?) death will never be denied () () (both?) (n) should divide Lord grant that we may meet again In heaven for ever and alway(s?)"	

D9. (Close to) this stone lies the remains of John the husband of Mary Remmonds who died Feby. 9th 1819 aged 89 years. This stone is erected (by) (Joh)n and James their sons.	
D10. Shown in 1980 survey as an unreadable plaque on the church wall. No visible sign of it in 2008.	No sign of this plaque
D11. In memory of Charles the beloved husband of Elizth Bessey who died Octb. 27th 1866 aged 85 years. He was corporal in H.M. 34th Regt. And was engaged in eight battles during the Peninsular War.	









D24. In affectionate remembrance of Mary Ann the beloved wife of Rebert Smith who died Nov.17th 1906 aged 78 years. "Tis hard to part with those we love, Bur Jesus knows what's best; And in our Father's house above Our loved one is at rest." Perfitt Stalham D25. In loving memory of Annie the beloved daughter of William and Sarah Millett who died Jan. 2 1884 aged 13 years. "Weep not she is not dead but sleepeth." Luke VIII 52. D26. Sacred to the memory of Emma the beloved daughter of Will m and Hannah Colls who died 11th July 1849 ---- ground level (aged 21)
